REQUIRED EQUIPMENT

- 1 Duffle Bag or Locker
 - Maximum Size 36" x 18" x 20"
- 1 Combination Lock
- 1 Day Pack (for on the bus, and walking around Washington D.C. and Jamboree)
- 2 Blankets/sheets or one sleeping bag, or combination of both.
- 1 Cot
- 1 Ground Cloth
- 1 Rain Gear
- 1 Jamboree Name Tag (Provided by Troop)
- 2 Pairs of Scout Pants (Zip off Kind)
- 1 Scout Hat (Provided by Troop)
- 2 Class A Scout Shirts
 - Must have all Correct patches for Jamboree
 - 2 Sets of Patches Provided by Troop
 - Troop Numbers
 - Patrol Patches
 - Leadership Patches (SPL, Patrol Leader, etc)
 - Council Strips
 - Participant Patches
 - World Crests
- 1 Scout Belt
- 4 Pairs of Official Scout Socks
- 2 pairs of shoes/boots (well broken in)
- 1 Jamboree neckerchief (Provided at Jamboree)
- 1 Neckerchief slide
- 4 Class B Scout Shirts (2 Troop Jamboree Shirts will be provided)
- 4 sets of underwear
- 2 pairs of sleeping clothes
- 1 Laundry Bag for soiled Clothes
- 1 Laundry Materials (detergent in small plastic bag)
- 1 swimsuit
- 1 Pair of shower shoes
- 1 Pair of water shoes for White Water Rafting Trip (can be used as shower shoes)
- 1 Eating utensil set (bowl and/or plate, knife, spoon, fork, and cup)

- 1 Toilet Kit (soap in a container, shampoo, comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, non-breakable mirror, deodorant, washcloth, and shaving gear (if needed))
- 1 Beach Towel for Pool, Lake and Rafting Trip
- 2 Bath Towels
- 2 Hand Towels
- 1 Sewing Kit
- 1 Flashlight
- 1 Knife (Locking Blade Only)
- 1 Bible or Prayer Book—according to faith
- 1 Water Bottle
- 1 Insect Repellent (NO aerosols)
- 1 Sunscreen (NO aerosols)
- 1 Watch
- 1 Red Jacket

OPTIONAL PERSONAL EQUIPMENT

- 3rd Class A Scout Shirt with proper patches
- Folding Camp Chair
- Notebook, pen/pencil
- Camera and Accessories
- Drinking Cup
- Shoelaces (extra pair)
- Pillow
- Boy Scout Handbook
- Electric Lantern (Spare Battery and Bulb)
- Wallet
- Sunglasses
- Clothing Hangers
- Water Bladder (Camel Back)
- Nylon Rope for Clothes Line
- Clothespins
- Playing cards
- Foot Powder (Gold Bond medicated)

UNIFORM STANDARDS

- “Sturdy shoes” means a rugged type boot or shoe good for walking or hiking. Open-toed shoes or sandals are NOT PERMITTED
- T-shirts for Class B wear can be any BSA camp or home troop as approved by your Scoutmaster. You must have your Jamboree Troop Shirts with you.
- You must be in uniform at all times while participating in, preparing for, traveling to and from and while at the jamboree. No logo-commercial, school or sports, is permitted.
- Dry feet are a great thing at the jamboree. Extra socks are strongly suggested. Chaffing can also be a problem so clean underwear is a must. You will do your own laundry there, but you will still be expected to be in proper uniform, even on laundry day. Pack accordingly.

ITEMS NOT PERMITTED

Laser pointers, tobacco products of any kind, alcohol, or medications not prescribed, firearms and fireworks of any kind are considered contraband and will result in the scout being sent home.

None Scout Shirts or clothing, other than sleepwear is allowed.

REMEMBER.....

Scout socks are worn at all times!!! Scout shorts are worn at all times!!!! Regardless of condition or smell!!! Learn to do Laundry or bring lot of extra clothes!!!

What is listed above is only the minimum required amount feel free to bring extras!!!

LABEL EVERYTHING!!!!!!!

Label or mark everything that goes to Jamboree! Again mark EVERYTHING that goes to Jamboree! At a minimum use your initials, if space permits include your name and Jamboree Troop number, which is the only way to identify boys at Jamboree. So, mark your clothes and gear as such: Johnny Scout, Troop 1123. Labeled clothing/gear, even socks, often get back to their owners. You wouldn't believe how many items end up in the lost and found building.
